### Summary of Facts and Submissions

- I. The appeal is against the decision of the Opposition Division posted 31<sup>st</sup> January 2006 to revoke the European Patent 1069942.
- II. The Patentee (Appellant) filed on 10<sup>th</sup> April 2006 an appeal against this decision and paid the appeal fee simultaneously; the grounds of appeal were filed on 12<sup>th</sup> June 2006.
- III. With his letter dated 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2009 answering to the summons to oral proceedings issued by the Board, the Appellant informed the Board as follows: "I write to advise you that the proprietor, Symyx Technologies, Inc will not be attending Oral Proceedings. In addition, I hereby withdraw all claim requests before the Board."
- IV. With the official communication dated 08<sup>th</sup> April 2009 the Board pointed out that this submission being unclear, the Appellant was invited to clarify.

Furthermore it was stated that in case of absence of any reply within a period of two months, the appeal would be considered withdrawn.

V. The Appellant did not submit any reply within the given time limit.

## Reasons for the Decision

Given the reasons mentioned above the Board interprets Appellant's statement of  $22^{nd}$  January 2009 as a withdrawal of the appeal.
