Summary of Facts

1. By letter dated 16 October 1984 the Appellant gave notice of appeal against the Decision of the Opposition Division of the European Patent Office dated 17 August 1984 rejecting the opposition against European patent No. 0 008 297. The appeal fee was duly paid.

2. On 18 January 1985 a written statement setting out the grounds of appeal was filed and received on 19 January 1985.

Reasons for the Decision

As no written statement setting out the grounds of appeal has been filed in conformity with Article 108 EPC, last sentence, and Rule 78(3) EPC the Board is required to reject this appeal as inadmissible in accordance with the provisions of Rule 65(1) EPC.
